First Article Report (FAR) Requirements

First Article Reports

TransAct follows an ISO approved First Article process

- FAR's are required for:
 - New parts, revisions and products (RFC says FAR Y/N)
 - Process, component or BOM changes
 - New Suppliers or Vendors
 - Every cavity of multiple cavity tools
- FAR's shall be submitted electronically via email.
- FAR samples shall be identified, with a hard copy of FAR paperwork enclosed.
- FAR submissions are assigned a TransAct FAR number and submitted into the process for disposition.
- A notice of approved or rejected FAR submission is sent electronically, along with any further instructions.


First Article Reports

FAR Checklist (Level 3):

- Cover page with submission date, TransAct and Supplier PN & revision, part description, and reason for submission (new part, revised part, new sub-supplier, etc.)
- Bubbled Drawing with numerical reference to all dimensions and tolerances, packaging/labeling requirements & notes
- Inspection Report addressing all dimensions and tolerances, packaging/labeling requirements & notes
- Process Flow
- Production Control Plan
- Material Certification of Conformance (if applicable)
- RoHS certification
- Applicable Cpk studies
- FAR samples


Level 3 - Full FAR

CM shall review and validate FAR package is complete and requirements are fully met in this step



Level 2 – On Site FAR Approval

CM shall review and validate FAR package is complete and requirements are fully met in this step. Sometimes an abbreviated FAR will be used.



Level 1 FAR

- FAR submission not required for Level 1 components
