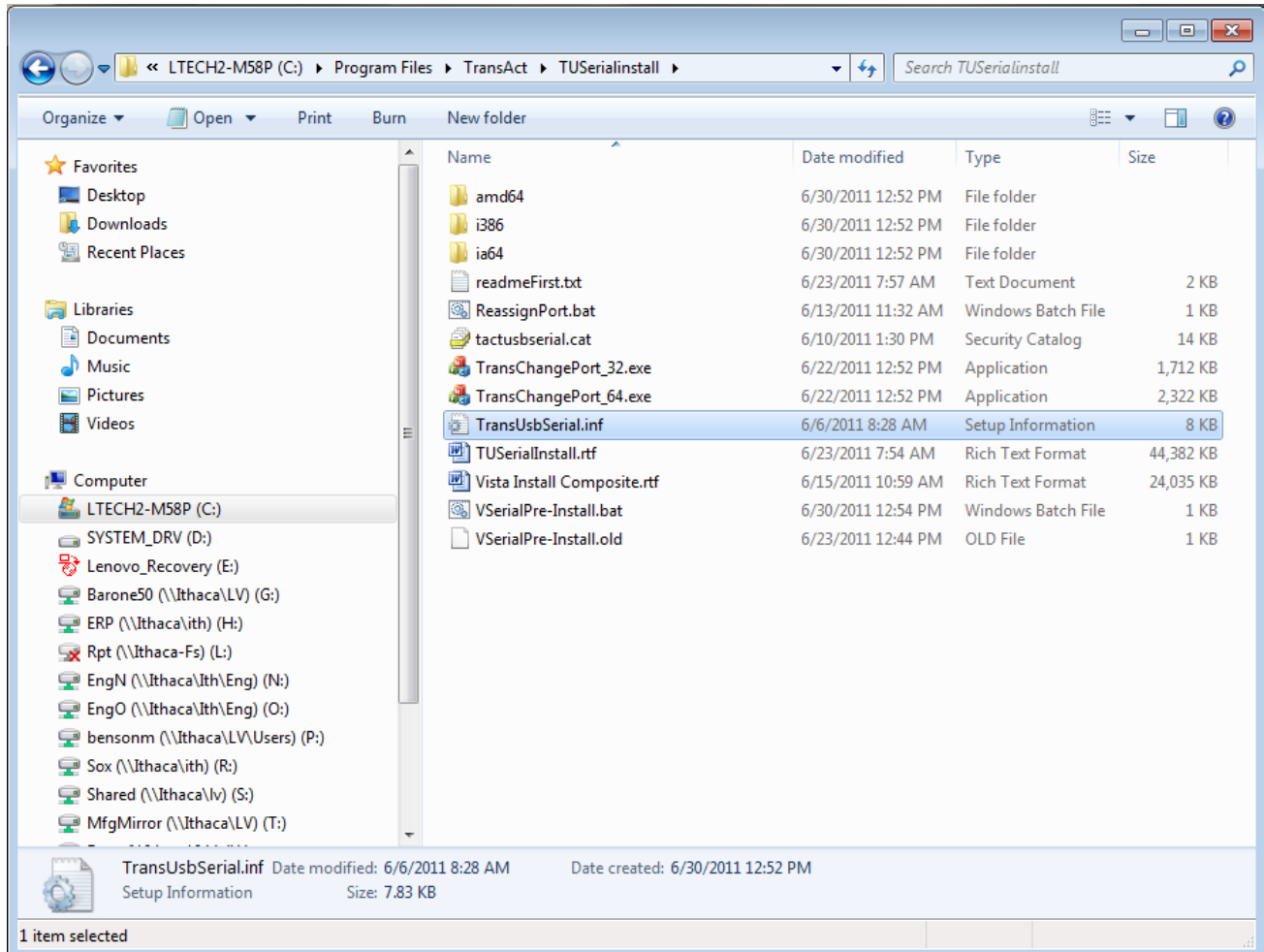


TransAct Virtual Serial Port Standard Installation Example

- 1.) Unzip TUSerialinstall.zip file to a folder. Example: C:\Program Files\Transact\TUSerialinstall.

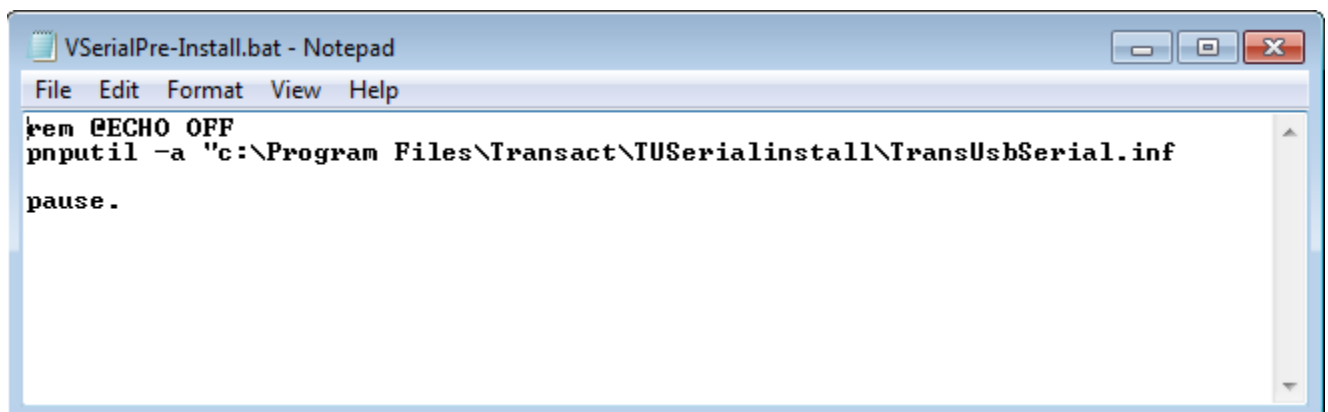


- 2.) Edited the VSerialPre-Install.bat to reflect the installed folder. (Right click, Edit.)


Example:

If files were unzipped to the folder: C:\Program Files\Transact\TUSerialinstall

Change file to:



- 3.) Next run this edited VSerialPre-Install.bat file by right clicking on the file and selecting Run as Administrator.
 - a.) File must run as Administrator.
 - b.) Also, make sure you see "Number successfully imported: 1 ", after running.
 - c.) Press any key to close the Windows.

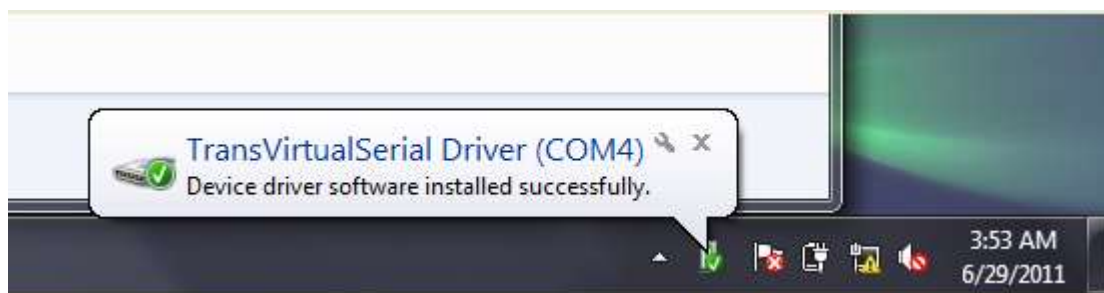

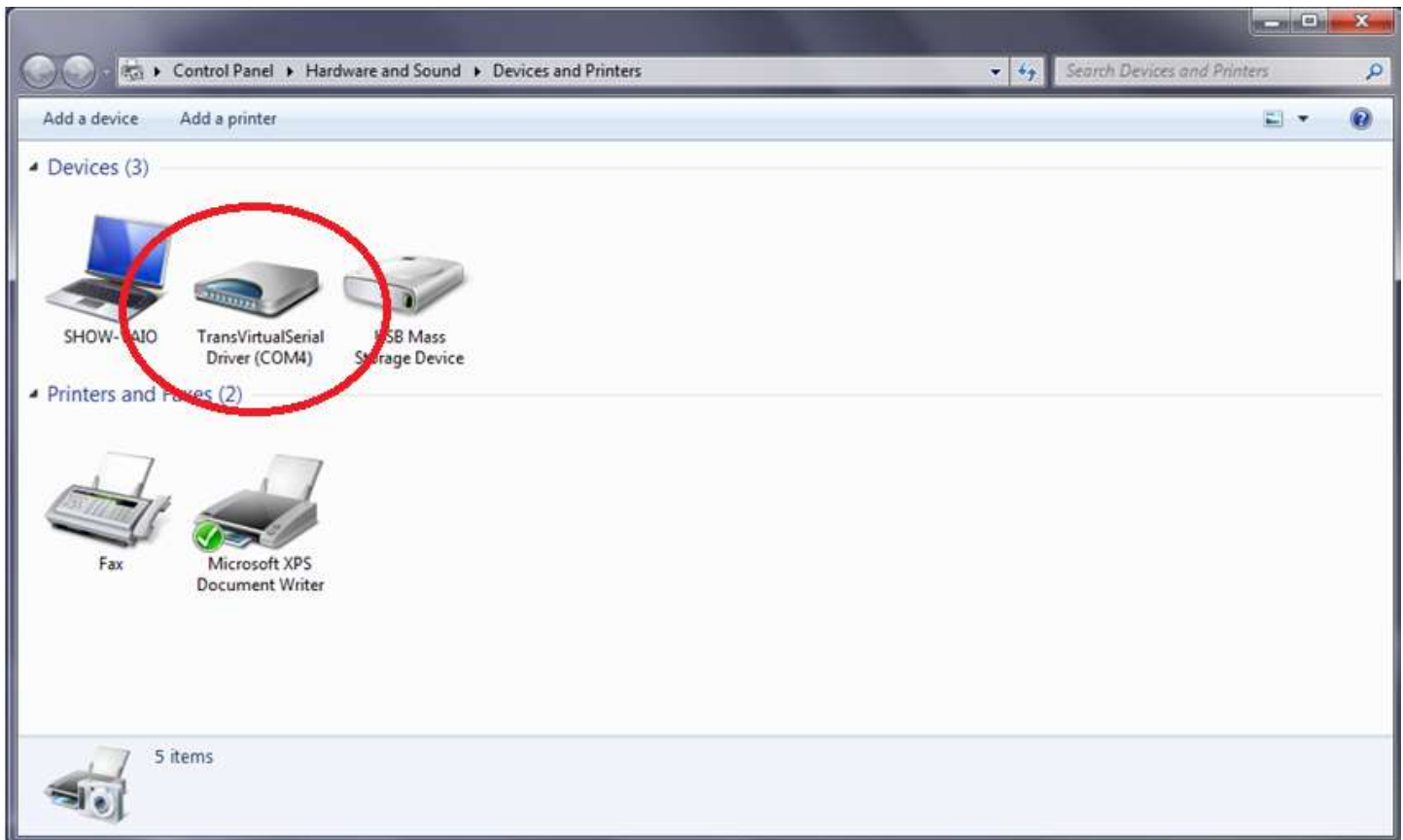

- 4.) Power the printer on.
- 5.) Verify the printer is in a Ready state. Paper is loaded, and has no errors, only the Green LEDs.
- 6.) Plug the USB cable into the printer.
- 7.) Plug the USB cable into the PC.
- 8.) Install should occur and you should get a successful install message:



9.) You should now see a TransVirtualSerial driver under Devices in Devices and Printers.



10.) TransAct Virtual Serial Driver is now installed.

NOTE: This driver is for Legacy software that cannot use the USB port directly. This allows an application to talk to a USB printer through a virtual COM port. If your software application can use the USB port directly, or your software application requires a Windows driver, you do not need to install this driver.
